

HOW TO BE A GOOD SPECTATOR

A FEW GUIDELINES TO REMEMBER AT THE THEATRE



BATHROOM USE

Except in case of pressing emergency, please refrain from using the bathroom after the start of the performance. This will prevent missing any part of the storyline and disturbing others.



LISTENING QUIETLY

To fully appreciate the play, please keep your comments for the end of the performance. Silence helps us understand and perceive the text subtleties.



ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN THE SHOW

During an interactive show, actors and actresses may invite a member of the audience to speak and even go on stage. Otherwise, you are invited to listen carefully to the story.



THEATRE AND EMOTIONS

Just like at the movies, theatre can make you feel emotional. Please keep in mind that the show happens on stage; overreactions can disturb the rest of the audience.



PERSONAL ITEMS AND ELECTRONIC DEVICES

To avoid any distractions, the public is requested to put personal items away and to switch off all electronic devices.



VIDEO RECORDING AND PHOTOGRAPHY

A play is a work of art subject to copyright. Images are readily available on the theatre webpage or on Facebook.



EATING AND DRINKING

At the theatre, eating and drinking is not permitted unless told otherwise by actors. Please wait until the end of the performance to get a snack or a drink.



BAGS, COATS, ETC

To avoid disrupting the play, I take off my coat and I put down my bag to be comfortable in my seat.



AFTER THE PLAY IS OVER

During the curtain call, it is customary to recognize the actors and actresses with a hearty round of applause. It is also a good time to ask questions.
