SUPPORT GUIDE La Voyageuse



Hi, the Théâtre Les Confettis and Théâtre La Seizième teams thank you for welcoming our travelling suitcase in your class!

You'll see, the installation is easy and only takes a few minutes.

Here are the 6 steps to follow; we suggest installing everything before students arrive in class.



You've received the suitcase: you can leave it on the ground because it is a little heavy.

You open the suitcase: inside, in addition to the hardware, you will find:

- -an installation guide taped to the lid of the suitcase
- -a laminated summary of the activity

INSTALLATION

Step 1 Plug in the suitcase to a wall outlet.

Please note the plug is purple like it is on the guide.

Place the speakers around the students, oriented towards them and at ear height.

Steps 2, 3, 4 & 5 It is important to follow the layout for the order in which to lay out the speakers.

- · Blue: Front of the class to the left
- · Green: Back of the class to the left
- · Yellow: Back of the class to the right
- · White: Front of the class to the right

Check once more that the speakers are oriented towards the students and at ear height.

Connect the appropriate USB key for your class. You will see written on the key: "Kindergarten to grade 3" or "Grade 3 to grade 6".

Step 6 Notice the USB key is red and the outlet in which to plug it in is also red. There you go, it's installed! Now the students can enter. Make them aware of any and all wires.

THE JOURNEY



Create a welcoming environment to help with the listening experience. Turn down the lights, invite your students to breathe deeply. It is important to be calm and concentrated in order to fully enjoy the listening experience without any visual support material. Then, read the letter *La Voyageuse*, which you will find in the laminated summary of the activity.

Hit the "Play" button only once, and listen to the story. You do not need to do anything else, the sound is already adjusted.

Once it is over, you can reflect on the experience you've just had and then offer to complete the complementary activity of the postcard.

THE CLEAN UP



Bring all the equipment together and delicately disinfect it with the wipes included in the suitcase. You can use the photo in the lid to see how everything fits in the the suitcase. Spool the wires around the coil. Put the speakers back in their spot, reverse the steps from the set up in order not to cross any wires (5,4,3,2,1), place the electric cord in the lid, place the laminated summary in the lid. Close the suitcase and make sure that it gets to the next class. Easy as that!

All that's left is to fill out the postcard "Rapport de voyage de l'enseignant.e" and to hand it back to the person in charge of the project.
